## **LILY PHOTO CONTEST**

**Eligibility:** the Photo Contest is open to NALS members as well as non-members.

**Scope:** All photos must feature members of the genus *Lilium*. Photos may be of a single lily flower or multiple flowers, a single lily plant, or multiple plants grouped in a flower bed, a vase or similar arrangement. Close-ups are acceptable where the photo clearly depicts the subject as a member of the genus *Lilium*.

**Out of scope:** The focus of the photos is lilies. Please note that classes indicate where people, animals, insects, or other subjects/objects are allowed as part of the image. Otherwise, the photo's main focus should be lilies.

### Two entry divisions:

A. Competition Division: <u>Amateur photographers only</u>. Photos cannot have been entered in previous NALS Photo Contests. Please enter no more than one photo per class. *Division A winners are determined by ballots cast by Show attendees. Vote tabulation takes place Saturday July 11<sup>th</sup>, 5:00pm.* 

#### **Division A Classes**

Class 1 Close up – Beauty is in the details – fill the frame
Class 2 Abstraction – An open invitation for any interpretation

Class 3	Grand Vista - Any landscape or garden featuring lilies
Class 4	Companions and Pollinators – Your opportunity to include
	butterflies, bees, insects and human companions
Class 5	My Favourite Lily/Lilies – Your choice
Class 6	Show Time – Photos of National or Regional Symposiums and
	Shows
Class 7	Companions – Show us your companion plantings with lilies

B. Exhibition Division: <u>Open to all photographers and previously entered photographs</u>. There is no limit on the number of entries per entrant in this Division.

#### **Entry information:**

- 1. Photos <u>must</u> be 8"x10" or 8 1/2"x11" in size, and <u>must</u> be mounted on 1/8" or ½" thick cardboard, poster-board, or foam-board of the same size as the photo.
- 2. The back of the photo must contain the following information:
  - a. Entrant's name, address, phone-number and e-mail
  - b. The Division and Class the photo is to be entered in (either "Div A" or "Div B")
  - c. The name of the lily or lilies ("Unknown Lily" or "Unknown Lilies" is acceptable)
- 3. Where deemed appropriate, the Show Committee has the right to place photos in a Division or Division Class different from the one the photographer indicated, or choose to not display a photo. This is a public event and must be family friendly.
- 4. Participants retain all legal rights to their photos, but grant NALS permission to use entered photos for non-commercial educational and promotional purposes on websites, in written publications, etc.
- 5. Entry deadlines:
  - a. mailed entries must be received by Friday, June 26, 2020 (address below)
  - b. entries delivered in person must be delivered by Thursday, July 9, 2020, at 5:00pm to the Lily Competition Show Table in the Atrium.
- 6. Participants may pick up their entries at the end of the Lily Show, Sunday July 11, 2020 between 3:00 & 4:00 pm. Entries not picked up will become part of the Lily Society's library.

- 8. Do not send self-addressed envelopes for return by mail: U.S. attendees should make individual arrangements with a U.S. show attendee to subsequently mail your entry to you from the U.S. as Canadian stamps are required in Canada.
